Thank you for your child's and their teacher's interest in the Forestry Challenge. The Forestry Challenge is a competitive forestry event for high school students. Four events are scheduled this fall for Wednesdays through Saturdays in Shasta County (September 29 to October 2), Santa Cruz County (October 13 to 16), El Dorado County (October 27 to 30), and San Bernardino County (November 10 to 13). Participating students and their teacher/advisor will be away from campus for two school days, a Thursday and a Friday. While off campus, they will have a unique opportunity to learn about the forest.

Please note that the registration fee varies by location, ranging from \$120 to \$215 per person, only because of the differing costs of the facilities, not because of any program differences. The fee is due on the start date of the event and covers food, lodging for three nights, and an event t-shirt. If you and/or the school are unable to pay the fee, your school can request assistance. No one has ever been prevented from attending because they did not have the funds.

Students are supervised at all times and stay in cabins or dorms with an adult chaperone. All educational and social activities are conducted in a safe and fun environment. There will be an RN on staff who has advanced training in outdoor emergency care.
