2018 SHASTA FORESTRY CHALLENGE
JUDGE'S SCORE SHEET FOR FOCUS TOPIC PRESENTATION

Part 1 – Application of data (60 points)

The team demonstrated a solid understanding of:

- The history of the mixed conifer forest in the Shingletown area and changes resulting from exclusion of natural fire 1 2 3 4 5
- Basic fire behavior, including fire triangles and the fire fuel ladder 1 2 3 4 5
- CA Forest Practice Rules and regulations available to initiate a harvest on the unit, including THP's, exemptions, and emergency notices 1 2 3 4 5
- Understory fuels treatments and post-harvest maintenance options 1 2 3 4 5

The presentation included one or more maps and/or aerial photographs of the unit, including the general location and inventory plot locations 1 2 3 4 5

The team described their data collection techniques and presented data on all parameters measured during the inventory 1 2 3 4 5

The team recommended one regulatory mechanism to use to conduct a timber harvest on the unit and explained why it is the best option 2 4 6 8 10

The team recommended one or a combination of understory fuels treatments to reduce ladder fuels and logging debris 2 4 6 8 10

The team outlined a 5 to 10 year post treatment plan for maintenance of the brush and understory 1 2 3 4 5

The recommendation was based on interviews, observations, and data the team collected, with specific reference sources cited 1 2 3 4 5
