Announcing four Forestry Challenge events in the fall of 2022

Shasta - September 28 to October 1
Mountain Meadows Camp east of Redding - \$120/person*

Santa Cruz - October 12 to 15
Redwood Glen near Loma Mar - \$215/person*

El Dorado - October 26 to 29
Leoni Meadows Camp south of Placerville - \$130/person*

San Bernardino - November 9 to 12
Hume SoCal near Lake Arrowhead - \$215/person*

Schools can attend any event that is the best fit for location, school schedule, and student interest.

*Registration fees listed above for 2021 registration, and 2022 fees will be similar. Pre-register by June 30, 2022, to qualify for a registration fee discount of 50% or more. This does not financially obligate you or your group in any way. Stipends are available upon request for substitute teachers and transportation.

The Forestry Challenge is an academic event for high school students in technical forestry and current forestry topics. Participants spend four days in the forest learning about the ecology and management of the forested landscapes that provide communities with water, recreational opportunities, wood products, and wildlife habitat. Students take on a rigorous critical thinking exercise which is timely and addresses current forestry topics such as wildfire, insects, and forest health.
